Investing in Grace

Eighteen-year-old Grace signed up to attend the Life and Leadership Training program this past summer (a 6-week internship Youth Dynamics offers high school students). Of the \$2,100 needed for the program, she had raised all but \$965 and applied for a scholarship to help her cover the gap. She said:

"Getting this scholarship would help me focus on my Life and Leadership Training program and gain the experience I need to further my relationship with Christ. I want to be fully present during the program to learn what it means to be a leader and a servant of God.

Not growing up in the church and learning who Jesus is through Youth Dynamics has been such a blessing, but I don't have many contacts or people in my life outside of Youth Dynamics that see my walk with Christ as valid."

When her program concluded, Grace shared what impact this experience had on her life and what she learned about her faith journey.

"As someone who loves the outdoors, I didn't face anything that I thought I would not be able to do. However, part of the leadership program involved assisting with other adventure trips, which meant I had to engage socially with other participants as a leader. I found myself most hesitant in those situations.

Before I left, I had a diagnosis for seizures and experienced an episode early in training. What impacted me the most through that experience was the staff who reassured me and made sure my needs were met. Their kindness shifted my willingness to

trust people, as well as my internal perspective on how worthy I am to be cared for. After that experience, I realized I was less anxious about making meaningful connections with students. I put more intentionality into making the students feel as seen and cared for as I did when facing something scary.

Thank you for helping me be fully present during the Life and Leadership Training and providing the opportunity to get the hands-on involvement I needed to grow in my walk with Christ. I am excited by this experience and will put this training towards my youth ministry involvement in the future."

Grace is one of the hundreds of students who had a life-changing experience this summer because of people like you who support the ministry of Youth Dynamics. Thank you!

It blows my mind how it was so natural for students to open up—as if being in creation opens up vulnerability for these students. Several conversations took place at our campsite following our rock-climbing experience as well, for which

two students made new decisions for Christ! Another student caught me after our devotional and shared he had contemplated suicide several times in 2020. This seventh-grader looked me in the eye and said, "Sean, what you shared from the Bible tonight resonated with me, and I want to rededicate my life to Christ!"
