Leah*, 14, knows what it's like to live between two worlds. Because her parents are divorced, she splits her time between Anacortes, WA, and another state. She is constantly adjusting to different homes, communities, and expectations. That kind of instability can leave a young person feeling unanchored.

Last year, Leah was introduced to Youth Dynamics in Anacortes and met staff member Kayleigh McClay. Kayleigh welcomed her with open arms, building a relationship rooted in trust and authenticity. Leah opened up about the tug-of-war in her heart, torn between fitting in with peers and exploring what it might mean to follow Jesus.

This past summer, Leah joined a Youth Dynamics rafting trip on the remote Owyhee River, a weeklong adventure packed with hundreds of rapids and deeper encounters with the Gospel. Additionally, Leah got connected to a local church. Together, these influences changed the course of Leah's life, and the seeds of faith took root.

Not long after, Leah said yes to following Jesus and made the bold decision to be baptized by her local church. When Kayleigh asked her what led to that step, Leah shared, "I've been trying to find God for the past couple of years. But this time, I felt like He was saying it's time to get serious about my faith."

Kayleigh continues to walk with Leah, because at Youth Dynamics, the adventure is just the beginning. Through your prayers and support, youth like Leah are finding Jesus and learning to walk with Him for life.

Why I Said Yes to Youth Dynamics

My name is Aaron Bevier, and this is part of my journey to join Youth Dynamics. I live in a small, rural town in Washington called Tonasket. After the pandemic, I spent a year as a substitute teacher in our school district. It was fulfilling but challenging. Whether in the classroom, hallways, or playground, I felt the need to share the hope of Christ with kids—but I couldn't do that in the school setting.

Around that time, my son was entering 6th grade, and I realized there were no youth ministries left in our community. Nearly all had disappeared during COVID. My wife and I felt convicted to begin something to meet that need. I had been close friends with Youth Dynamics' staff member Bronco Huge for 16 years, and after conversations with him and another staff member, they asked me to prayerfully consider joining Youth Dynamics full-time. It was a no-brainer! I came on staff in the fall of 2023, following the Lord's leading to reach youth in Tonasket.

I felt honored to be called, but
I wrestled with self-doubt. I was
still recovering from a roofing
accident that initially left
me with memory loss and
unable to walk or read. I was
unsure if I could keep up with the
adventure ministry—rafting, rock
climbing, hiking, and more. Then I

realized young people feel the same fears—nervous, incapable, overwhelmed. If I stepped into it with them, side by side, it could grow bonds and point them to Christ.

Now, at 44, I work with adventure guides, some young enough to be my kids, and I love it. Through Youth Dynamics Adventures and Community Ministries, we create space for students to shrug off distractions and discover abundant life in Jesus.

This ministry has grown my heart in thankfulness. It calls me to daily excellence—professionally, personally, and spiritually. Though I live far from most staff, I've never felt alone. Their love and support have brought me to tears.

Locally, our churches and partners have been incredible, reminding me this work is not just me—it is all of us together in Christ. And above all, I'm thankful for Christ Himself—His grace, mercy, strength, and humility sustain me every day.
