Jenna's Story

*Jenna grew up with a mother who struggled with substance use. She told us, "When she was drunk, she got irritable and mean, and there was a new man in the house every week." About a year ago, her mother left and stopped communicating with her.

Jenna moved in with her dad and stepmom and started attending church. She felt alone at first, but "everyone was very loving and nice," and she decided that she wanted to explore her relationship with God. So, Jenna applied for a scholarship to attend a horse camp this summer at Stonewater, our Washington adventure base and retreat center.

It was her first time attending any Youth Dynamics event. Initially, she was shy and scared, but our amazing campers and leaders were warm and welcoming and helped her feel comfortable. Our theme for the summer was "God sees you," and we made sure Jenna felt seen that week.

She said, "I used to think I wanted to be like my mom. I realize now that she lied a lot about who she was. I want to be on the right, godly path, unlike the one my mother ended up on." Jenna learned more about God's love for her during the week through the love of the other campers and our leaders and gave her life to Christ.

When asked what she wanted to say to those who made her scholarship possible, Jenna said, "Thank you for this amazing opportunity. This week, I gave my life to Christ.

Growing up how I did, feeling

this safe was strange, and life-changing. I had never felt safe before."

This is just one example of the difference that time with God, with nature, and with people that care can make. Your prayer, your presence, and your partnership are what make the difference.

During Jenna's time with us, she "found God and a new home with her dad and stepmom." Thank you for the difference that you make in the lives of young people.

Ministry At-A-Glance

Youth Dynamics has three core ministries. Each ministry seeks to create a non-threatening environment where students can experience adventure, build relationships with caring adults, and hear the good news of Jesus Christ.

COMMUNITIES: Relational adventure ministry with youth from a specific community, neighborhood, or location.

ADVENTURES: Professionally guided river trips, backcountry trips, mountain and rock climbing, horse camp, and summer and winter adventures.

RETREATS: Stonewater offers adventures, leadership training, and retreat ministry.
